Language requirements

English language proficiency (B2 or higher) - English track

Italian language proficiency (B2 or higher) - Italian track

No specific certificate required, for clarifications please get in contact with NABA International Exchanges Office

Please take into account that from the academic year 2021/22 the Italian Ministry of University and Research (MUR) has set a new regulation for non-European students willing to come to study in Italy. For this reason, we need to receive also a language certification, among the other documents required in the application form, attesting the English or Italian level of the students (according to the track chosen). Please notice that if students do not have any linguistic certification and they are accepted for an exchange programme in NABA, they may get in contact with NABA International Students and Exchange Programmes Office for further support.

Visa requirements

If students are citizens of a country outside the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland, they will need a Student Visa, for which they should apply in early advance before leaving their home country.
