1) Why you are receiving this communication

Nuova Accademia S.r.l., as Data Controller, wishes to inform you about the type of data we collect and the methods we use to do this, in order to guarantee respect for your fundamental rights and freedoms, with particular reference to the confidentiality and security with which the data are processed.

2) What personal data we collect

For the pursuit of the purposes set out below, the Controller will, as appropriate and where necessary, process personal data belonging to the following categories

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. collects and stores your personal data at the time of enrolment/registration:

- Identifying data such as given name, surname, residential address, email address, studies completed, citizenship, gender, place and date of birth, telephone number, copy of identity card/passport;
- Your banking data and/or those belonging to the personmaking the payment;
- Possible person to be contacted for administrative aspects, including payments;
- Information about your/your family income, assets;
- Possible rental lease for non-resident students;
- Any medical certifications proving disability;
- Academic career / curriculum vitae:
- Copy of identity card/passport of the person who acts as the student's legal guardian;
- Student's images.

The data are collected at the time of enrolment through completion of the matriculation form and by the sending of the required documentation or uploading it onto the personal student area.

The following data are collected subsequent to enrolment/registration:

- Tax documentation necessary to verify/confirm the student'sincome bracket;
- Any medical certifications proving illness or disability;
- Student's images/recordings collected during events;
- Data related to academic evaluations.

3) For what purposes we use your personal data

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. uses your data for the following purposes:

- ■To fulfil pre-contractual and contractual obligations, to allow your enrolment in the course of your choice, as well as the provision of services connected to it;
- To handle money collections and payments, deriving from contractual obligations, including credit recovery;
- ■To provide online services, including the issue of the electronic student grades booklet;
- To create your user account and your relative email account;
- To create your student ID card;
- ■To enable access to web-based platforms and to apps connected to Nuova Accademia S.r.l., in order to allow access to/modification of the study plan, exams enrolments, refusal of grades, in accordance with the student regulations, presentation of final diploma examination admission application, and displaying of presences and absences;

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. is part of the Galileo Global Education Italia Group. Upon your explicit consent, the data may be transferred to otherInstitutes of the Galileo Global Education Italia Group to promote courses based on the aptitudes and interests of each student or to enrich their studies.

The data may also be collected by the Galileo Global Education Italia Group in aggregate form to perform statistical analyses.

4)How long we retain your personal data

For the purposes referred to in point 3.2, we keep your data until consent is revoked and we guarantee the exercise of the rights of the data subject as referred to in point 9.



5)The security of your personal data

Your data will be processed using equipment that guarantees their confidentiality, integrity and availability. The processing is carried out on paper and through computerised and/or automated systems and will include all of the operations or sets of operations envisaged in Art. 4 of the GDPR which are necessary for the data processing, including communication with the subjects assigned to the processing itself. The data will not be disseminated; however, they will or may be communicated to public or private entities or individuals who operate within the context of the purposes described above.

6) Who can access your personal data

Only authorised persons can access your data in the context of the tasks assigned by Nuova Accademia S.r.l..

GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Audience

General entry requirements include:

At least 15 years of previous education

Holding a first level academic degree (Bachelor Degree or Academic Diploma) in fields related to the selected study programme

Certificate of English/Italian language (CEFR B1+ on entry)

The evaluation of an application is based on the positive assessment of both the Programme Leader and Admission Committee who will evaluate whether the degree and the technical skills correspond to requirements, and will identify possible educational credits or debts.

Master programmes are open also to students with not related degrees or diplomas, if the applicant is motivated by a research interest towards the topics of the programmes.

Participants not holding a first level Bachelor Degree/Academic Diploma will not earn the educational credits, but will receive a certificate of attendance (not recognised by MUR, Italian Ministry of University and Research) on successfully completing the programme.

B. Admission process

Within 7 days from the application submission, NABA Admissions Office will inform the candidates about the acceptance and, in case of positive feedback, will send the Admission Letter and Enrolment Form to the students. The admission will stay conditional until the legalized university degree and transcripts, copy of the Bachelor Degree/Academic diploma and the required language certificate are submitted to the school.

C. Deadlines

Please notice that each course has a limited number of places and enrolments will be closed when reaching the above mentioned limit.

When admission is confirmed, students are required to secure their place by returning the Enrolment Form and the receipt of payment of the pre-enrolment fee within 30 days from the Admission Letter's date.

D. Entry Requirements for Master of Arts Degree Programmes and Academic Master Programme according to the Italian Ministry of University and Research

In order to be eligible for admission to Italian universities/academies and therefore to be admitted into the NABA Master of Arts Degree Programmes and Academic Master Programmes, the Italian Ministry of University and Research has set the following mandatory regulations.

Students wishing to enrol in the Postgraduate Programmes are required to possess a first level university qualification which is considered eligible to enter the chosen programme. The title must meet the following requirements:

- be an official first cycle title belonging to the foreign system of reference and issued by an official institution of the foreign system;
- the title shall grant access to the second-cycle courses in the foreign system of reference;

the applicant's academic qualification shall be equivalent to the Italian qualification required to enter second-cycle programmes.

These requirements apply to all students with a foreign qualification, regardless of their nationality, and is valid both for qualifications issued within the European Union and non-EU countries.

For any questions about the validity of your degree, we kindly suggest that you contact the Italian Enic-Naric Centre – CIMEA in the country where your degree was issued.

E. Consular Procedures Non-EU Students Only

Students meeting the requirements above are requested to:
A) Start the pre-enrolment process through the Universitaly platform

ONLY FOR NON EU PASSPORT HOLDERS

Universitally is a website developed by the Italian Ministry of University and Research (MUR) with the aim of supporting students thorough their study experience in Italy.

The MUR established that all International non-European students willing to study in an Italian Academy or University should undertake the pre-enrolment procedures (a-bis) through Universitaly.

The pre-enrolment will give you the possibility to study at NABA and allow you to obtain the study VISA from the Italian authorities. Students are asked to pre-enrol and submit a copy of the passport, Bachelor Degree/Academic Diploma and transcripts on the Universitaly platform at https://www.universitaly.it/index.php/

Pre-enrolment applications are usually submitted between March and November of each year. This procedure is MANDATORY for students applying for any Master of Art Programme or Academic Master Programme.

Usually it takes **90 days to get the study visa**, that's why we suggest you to start the procedure as soon as possible.

Make sure you do not miss this deadline or your study visa request will be refused for enrollment to Italian Universities/Academies.

- B) Legalization of the following documents:
- 1. Legalization of the Bachelor Degree and Academic transcripts by the competent authorities in the country where the diploma was issued.
- 2. Translation into Italian or English made by a certified translator of the student's Bachelor Degree.
- 3. Translation into Italian or English made by a certified translator of the student's Academic Transcripts.

Translation is not needed for documents written in English, French, or Spanish.

The legalized and translated documents will be issued directly to you. Please make sure you submit them, together with a copy of the Bachelor Degree/Academic diploma to NABA



Admissions Office as soon as available, and anyway not later than the course beginning.

In case NABA needs some closure on student's secondary school diploma, the student must provide the Certificate for the equivalence of the qualification (Statement of Comparability) issued by the Italian Enic-Naric Centre – CIMEA https://cimea.diplo-me.eu/cimea/#/auth/login

In fact, enrolment to NABA Master of Arts Degree/Academic Master will be confirmed only after having submitted a copy of the Bachelor Degree/Academic diploma, a legalized translations as well as the requested language certificate.

F. Application for a Study Visa to Italy (for Non European students only)

To enrol for the NABA Two-year Master of Arts Degree Programme, students are requested to have an entry visa for enrolment to Italian Universities/Academies, called STUDIO per Immatricolazione Università - tipo D nazionale (see point A of previous section).

For the One-year Academic Master Programme, students are requested to have an entry visa for post-graduate study called STUDIO Post-Laurea tipo D nazionale.

WHEN: VISAS are released once the Pre-enrolment process through the Universitaly platform has been completed and received positive feedback from the Italian Diplomatic-Consular Representatives.

G. Language proficiency

NABA programmes are taught in Italian or English. Students are required to submit evidence of the knowledge of the language according to the chosen programme. The language certificate shall be submitted within one month before the beginning of the programme and should not be older than 2 years.

The requested level for Italian is an intermediate level (complete B1). Students that take CILS, CELI, CERT.IT, PLIDA Exams, for example, just need to pass with a final result equivalent to complete B1.
