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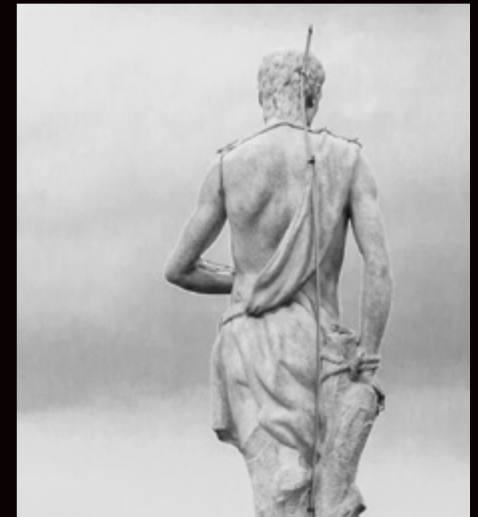
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**NABA, Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti** is an international Academy of Art and Design: it is the largest private Academy in Italy, the first one to have been recognised by the Italian Ministry of University and Research, back in 1981, and it was recently named by the prestigious **QS World University Rankings®** by **Subject 2021** as the **Best Academy of Fine Arts in Italy** and in the **top 100 worldwide in Art&Design field**. With its two campus in Milan and Rome, NABA offers academic diplomas equivalent to first and second level university degrees in the design, fashion design, communication and graphic design, media design and new technologies, set design, and visual arts areas, legally recognised at an international level.

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# MILAN

Milan is a city of significant international events such as the Fashion Weeks and the Design Week.



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NABA's campus in Milan is located near the Navigli area, one of the liveliest areas of the city, and is inserted in a historical architectural complex consisting of 13 buildings - spread over approximately 17,000 sqm - that include students' study and lounge areas, a green area, several specialised laboratories, a library, and a cafeteria.





# ROME

Rome is Italy's capital city, a showcase for art exhibitions, timeless and unique cultural places, and for important events such as the Altaroma Fashion Weeks and the Rome Film Fest.



The campus in Rome occupies two historical buildings dating back to the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century located in the Ostiense district, where artistic and cultural heritage meets contemporary culture. The campus covers an area of approximately 3,500 sqm with specialised laboratories, a library, as well as study and lounge areas.

# LABS

NABA has many specialised laboratories to provide students with the professional tools to create complex and interdisciplinary design projects, recreating real work teams, where fashion, design, communication, new technologies and art professions collaborate.



In addition to a Laser Cut, 3D Print and CNC Milling Machine area, where 3D models and prototypes can be created and many types of materials can be cut and engraved to make three-dimensional objects, the labs of **Design** and **Set Design Areas** have several state of the art tools and machinery, as the ones for wood and plastic processing, a painting booth, thermoforming machines, and a professional chamber kiln for firing ceramics.

The **Media Design and New Technologies Area** labs hold professional audio/video tools like cameras, video cameras (as the RED cameras for digital film), optics, lighting, microphones. The Film Studio-Photo Studio Labs hold darkened spaces, backdrops, lights, sound stages with Green Screen and Ciclorama. The Tech Lab includes the last generation workstation for professional postproduction and high technological projects where tools for editing, colour grading, VFX, sound recording/mixing, 2D/3D animation, virtual and augmented reality are available.

Activities involving numerous artistic techniques, using different tools and materials, are available in the **Visual Arts Area** Labs. The Atelier is fully equipped and has a space dedicated to chalcographic engraving. NABA also has a Darkroom for photographic film development.

The **Fashion Design Area** comprises the Fashion Design, Textile, Knitting Labs and the Textile Library. Sartorial and knitwear activities are carried out to create apparel, through the FRAMIS, the SHIMA SEIKI machine and the LECTRA system, experimenting with many materials from the basics of creating garments or details up to the realisation of complex designs.

# NABA WITH COMPANIES AND INSTITUTIONS

A whole host of collaborations with other institutions and external partners allows NABA to share and extend its skills beyond the boundaries of the Academy.

NABA received numerous awards and accolades over the years: it was selected by **Domus Magazine** as one of Europe's Top 100 schools of Architecture and Design; it was included by **Frame Publishers** in the guide to the 30 World's Leading Graduate Design and Fashion Schools; according to the **Uni-Italia** (Centre for the academic promotion and orientation of study in Italy) research on AFAM institutes in A.Y. 2018/19, NABA is the Italian Academy of Fine Arts with the highest number of international students; it has been recently selected among the best European universities as a Partner of the interdisciplinary cultural project "**New European Bauhaus**", promoted by the Eu-

ropean Commission to build a sustainable future for the new generations.

Students have the opportunity to be involved in projects with international cultural **institutions**, such as Triennale Milano, Museo Teatrale alla Scala, MAXXI Museo nazionale delle arti del XXI secolo, and Rome Film Fest.

NABA collaborates with renowned **companies** to simulate the dynamics of the professional world looking for innovative and creative visions: design methods are at the core of the didactic activities, allowing an idea to relate with a real context.
