COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will develop their drawing skills while exploring the ancient city of Rome, its monuments, museums, and the everyday places where Roman people gather to enjoy life. As they make quick drawing and painting sketches outdoor and indoor different environments, they will practice how to capture tone, colour, light, and atmosphere by using a variety of drawing and painting techniques.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The course aims to provide and strengthen a horizon to the practice of drawing as a cognitive and not just illustrative attitude.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Basical drawing and painting skills

OUTPUT

At the end of the course, each student will have produced a personal folder that will collect all the personal and guided studies, given by the study on the relationship between the human being, the historical-social environment and the urban one, using the city of Rome as an object of study in itself and as a catalyst of complexity and paradigms.
